The following is a recent rescue by Vail Mountain Rescue Group.



Recently a hiker called 911 to report that his friend had broken an ankle after slipping on ice on Resolution Road. The injured hiker, miles up the backcountry road near Ptarmigan Pass, was unable to walk out. Nine members of Vail Mountain Rescue Group, including an Eagle County Paramedic Services SAR paramedic, responded to the call. Using ATVs equipped with tire chains, rescuers located the injured hiker and his friend, and evacuated the party to their vehicle at Camp Hale.

Vail Mountain Rescue Group would like to acknowledge and thank all of the resources that participated in this mission, including the Eagle County Sheriff's Office, Eagle County Paramedic Services, Vail Public Safety Communications Center Dispatch, and the volunteer members of Vail Mountain Rescue Group.

This was the team's 113th mission of 2017, and the 150th subject rescued this year.
